Fields to complete with the organization

Do not treat this as a final scope of work until it is reviewed, priced and approved.

Field	Guidance
Organization / department	Ministry, directorate, facility, branch or enterprise unit.
Pilot location	Gate, checkpoint, building, perimeter, command room or field team area.
Operational objective	What must become more visible, controlled, faster or easier to report?
Included modules	Perimeter intelligence, checkpoint control, command room, field operations, evidence reporting, access control or ANPR/VMS readiness.
Excluded items	Items not included in the pilot, such as multi-site rollout or hardware purchase before survey approval.
User roles	Operators, supervisors, managers, administrators, procurement and IT/security reviewers.
Data rules	Allowed evidence, retention needs, export rules, access policy and confidentiality requirements.
Acceptance notes	What must be demonstrated before the pilot is accepted and expanded?
